

Ippen Shonin, a Historical Figure Associated with Beppu and Dogo

Ippen Shonin" from Matsuyama, who founded Kannawa Onsen, one of the eight hot springs in Beppu. He was the founder of the Jishu sect of Buddhism, known for its chanting and dancing incantation, and a native of Matsuyama. During his travels across Japan, he visited Kannawa in Beppu. It is said that Ippen Shonin calmed the land of Kannawa, which had been besieged by steam and heat, and established the Kannawa Steam Bath.



Beppu's Eight Hot Springs & Dogo Onsen

Beppu City, Oita Prefecture, with Eight Hot Spring Areas, is a town that boasts one of the largest number of hot springs and the largest volume of hot spring water gushing out in Japan. Dogo Onsen in Matsuyama City, Ehime Prefecture, is a place of many legends and history. These two cities are well known throughout Japan as hot spring tourist destinations, and are filled with many attractions such as gourmet food, cityscapes, and sightseeing spots.

Connecting Oita and Ehime Uwajima Transport Ferry

The Uwajima Transport Ferry provides a convenient connection between Beppu Port in Oita Prefecture and Yawatahama Port in Ehime Prefecture. With 6 daily departures, the ferry offers a scenic 3-hour journey between these beautiful regions.

The historic Dogo Onsen Main Building, discovered by a white heron and an Important Cultural Property, is a symbol of Dogo Onsen. It shares its natural alkaline spring water with Dogo Onsen Asuka-no-Yu and Dogo Onsen Tsubaki-no-Yu, all offering unaltered, direct-flowing water from the source.




Ippen Shonin, founder of the Jishu Sect, traveled Japan spreading his teachings and is honored in Beppu's Kannawa area for establishing its hot springs. Hōgonji Temple, his birthplace, features a restored statue, sacred images, and panels detailing his influential journey.
